



## LEADERSHIP WEEKEND INVITATION April 24<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup>, 2009

Dear Group Leader,

You are invited to the **13<sup>th</sup> Annual Cape Cod Sea Camps Leadership Weekend**. It will be held here on the grounds of the Cape Cod Sea Camps from Friday, April 24<sup>th</sup> to April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2009. The purpose of this weekend is to give leaders and their teams some time “on-Cape” before arriving at a later date with a group. It is an opportunity to learn something new about Cape Cod, about your team and just generally feel more at home here on Cape Cod – here at the Cape Cod Sea Camps.

We will begin the weekend Friday night with our opening dinner in our charming dining hall. Afterwards we gather in our beautiful Art Center and will hear a lecture given by **Jay Harrington, a local fisherman**. Jay is an expert on horseshoe crabs and will fill us in on the connection between a horseshoe crab, Woods Hole Oceanographic Laboratory (the “Crab Lab”!) and the modern medical world. This will be great! Jay has been on the National Geographic channel and on television in France, too. He has worked in these local, Cape Cod waters for over 30 years.

Saturday, we go in the field, as always. We will begin with time on the Atlantic Ocean side of the Lower Cape with **Lisa Sette, a member of the Whale Rescue Team at the Provincetown Center for Coastal Studies**. Lisa is also a seal expert and we hope to find some seals on this ocean walk. The location cannot be decided until the week that you are coming! This year we will be guided by **Tom Deshaies**. Tom is a retired middle school teacher who has taught for more than 30 years and has come here to Cape Cod Sea Camps with Sage Park Middle School for over 20 of those years. He knows Cape Cod and Cape Cod Bay VERY well and we will have this opportunity to get his best ideas and teaching methods right here at the beach at camp.

Saturday night is special, too. **Ken Kinkor, the historian for the Whydah Museum** located on MacMillan Wharf in Provincetown, will be our speaker. It is exciting! Ken has worked with the Whydah project – the world’s ONLY pirate treasure - for over 20 years and not only can tell us the local love story associated with the Whydah but can tell us the latest news about the national tour of the Whydah project. Remember that the end of April is a perfect time to visit the Brewster Grist Mill to experience the herring run, too. It is always a memorable thing to see nature’s seasons in action.
