You are invited to the **14th Annual Cape Cod Sea Camps Leadership Weekend**. It will be held here on the grounds of the Cape Cod Sea Camps from Friday, April 30th to Sunday, May 2nd, 2010. The purpose of this weekend is to give leaders and their teams some time “on-Cape” before arriving at a later date with a group. It is an opportunity to learn something new about Cape Cod, about your team and just generally feel more at home here on Cape Cod – here at the Cape Cod Sea Camps.

We will begin the weekend Friday night with dinner in our charming dining hall. Afterwards we gather in the beautiful Art Center. **Daniella Garran** is a middle school teacher at the Cape Cod Lighthouse Charter School here in Orleans and along with her students continues to stir up Cape Cod history with the “Cornerstone Project.” Daniella will share with us how history remains alive and relevant in her classroom today.

We will continue Cape Cod history with a lecture given by **Todd Morgan Kelley**. Todd is an historian, a naturalist and a native son whose Cape Cod family lineage goes back 12 generations to immigrants who arrived in 1652. Todd will focus his talk on **Cape Cod People, Culture and Landscape - On The Day The Pilgrims Arrived**. This will be fascinating – history at its best – told as an ongoing saga! Saturday we begin with time on the water – Wellfleet Harbor to be precise! We will board the vessel **Naviator** for a marine life cruise, hosted by our friends from **Wellfleet Bay Wildlife Sanctuary**. It will be fun to haul up a fish trap, a bay scallop drag and even do a plankton tow. We’ll bird watch, hear some more local history and even get out to Jeremy Point to observe seals.
